

**CORMORANT LAKE'S WATERSHED DISTRICT
APPLICATION FOR LAKESHORE IMPROVEMENT PERMIT**

District Regulations: No filling, excavating or grading shall be done on any premises within 300 feet of any public waters of said District unless permission is granted by the Board of Managers of said District. Application to fill, excavate or grade shall be made in writing to the Secretary of the District stating the location of the premises and the amount of filling, excavating and / or grading planned. Such application shall be approved or rejected by the Board within fourteen (14) days thereafter.

Permits must also be obtained from the Becker County Zoning Administrator for similar work within 1000 feet of public waters, and from the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources for similar work in public waters.

Proposed Work: Landscaping a small area, approximately 50 feet of shoreline, total shoreline owned is between 750 and 800 feet. The purpose of work is to open more sunlight to a Black Hills Spruce tree, and to develop a more attractive entry/exit to the lake.

Detail of Work: Remove 7 medium size trees, trunk diameter ranging from 3 to 6 inches, and replacing with perennial shrubs. The shrubs will include 7 or 8 Bergeson Dogwoods plus additional smaller shrubs such as Nanking Cherry, Nugget Ninebark, and Western Sandcherry, and other perennials. The current situation and proposed plan follow. Code for plants: EW=Existing woods, EB=Existing brush, EG=Existing grass, TR=Trees to be removed, DW=Dogwood, PS=Planted Shrubs, L=lakeshore
