**Next Meeting**: During the next regular scheduled meeting, the CLWD Board will be attending the Minnesota Association of Watershed District's annual meeting in Alexandria, MN where a quorum will be present. A special meeting is scheduled for December 19, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. in the Cormorant Town Hall/Community Center to attend to regular business.

**Treasurer's Report:** The financial report was presented and is on file.

**Inspectors Report:** Inspector Struble updated the Managers on his October Inspections. He reported:

## **New Business:**

- 1. Kip Moore presented his proposal for a future building on Tract C of a survey of Government Lots 4 6 of Section 18 Township 138 Range 48. His proposal was reviewed. A more detailed proposal was determined to be the next order of business to review.
- 2. Special Guest, Bob Merritt presented detailed information concerning Enbridge pipelines and possible routes for the future. An environmental impact statement will be forthcoming for Line 3 in January 2017. Some analysis may be prudent for protection of our groundwater and water supply. Mr. Merrit has the ability to conduct a groundwater study for the CLWD area. Motion by Jeff M. for the approval of Mr. Merrit's services for a local groundwater study and to cover his expenses for \$4,000 to review well log information. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Barbs H.
- 3. Gene O. presented information he learned about Invasive Species at an October AIS Workshop including:
  - a. Zebra Mussels-controversial new treatment which includes adding genetically modified species into lakes to eradicate the mussel populace
  - b. New propaganda that could be distributed to local bars/restaurants in the form of coasters and placemats.
  - c. Discussion of starry stone wort
- 4. Discourse on water runoff from structures and solutions to keep the water from entering area lakes.
