- 4. Discussion of lake survey prior to application of treatment for curly leaf pondweed.
- 5. Discussion of eco-harvesting tool, Eco-Harvester. Cost is approximately \$130,000
- 6. Middle Cormorant had small treatment for Curly Leaf Pondweed +/- 20 Acres.
- 7. Levy is indicated for one per property owner.
- 8. Ellis Peterson asked for a show of hands from the audience in favor of the assessment and majority raised their hands in support.
